

## PITTSTON SELECT BOARD MEETING

April 22, 2015

Meeting was called to order by Jean Ambrose at 6:00.

Those present: Jean Ambrose, Roger Linton, Sarah McLaughlin, Ernie Martin, Jim and Jeanne Lothridge, Larry Ireland, Tim Lawrence, Steve Costello, and Hope Ricker.

Ernie Martin had a question about his evaluation. His question was satisfied.

Jim Lothridge gave a brief summary of the Summit Natural Gas public safety awareness meeting that he attended.

Jim Lothridge reported that he was elected Chairperson for the Personnel Committee. Mr. Lothridge reported to the Select Board that the committee is still working on the job description for the Health Officer. He suggested that applicants have a back ground check done. Mr. Lothridge requested that the Select Board have Deb M. ask the City of Gardiner, Chelsea, and Randolph for a copy of the job description that they use for the Health Officer. The Board agreed and Deb M. will forward the information to Mr. Lothridge.

The Select Board requested that something be written for the Kennebec Journal stating that the Richmond Transfer Station is once again open for Pittston residents to use. Deb M. will take care of this.

The Budget Committee held a brief meeting to elect officers. Steve Costello is the Chairperson and Tim Lawrence is the secretary. Larry Ireland gave an update on projects being done at the Town Office: The drain in the document room has been patched, but still needs to be replaced, new windows have been ordered, shelves have been made in the cellar, and he will be getting new doors for the back room. Larry will also be taking care of a new pulley for the flag pole at the Town Office.

Roger Linton made a motion to approve the Select Board minutes of April 15. Jean Ambrose 2<sup>nd</sup>. It was a 2-0 vote.

The new flags for the cemeteries are in. Deb M. will call the contact people and have them picked up.

Deb Sullivan, Pittston's ACO, had come in to the Town Office to report that injured animals must be cleared by a veterinarian before they can go to the Humane Society. She wanted to know what vet. she should use. Questions were raised about who pays the vet. bill. Deb M. will get more information on this.

Warrant #15 was signed.

Jean Ambrose made a motion to approve preview warrant #16 in the amount of \$166,808.51. Roger Linton 2<sup>nd</sup>. It was a 2-0 vote.

Jean Ambrose made a motion to approve payroll warrant #1615 in the amount of \$2,110.38. Roger Linton 2<sup>nd</sup>. It was a 2-0 vote.

Sarah McLaughlin reported to the Select Board that she would be looking at foreclosures soon.

Jean Ambrose made a motion to adjourn at 7:22. Roger Linton 2<sup>nd</sup>. It was a 2-0 vote.
