

## **PITTSTON SELECT BOARD MEETING**

**October 14, 2015**

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chair, Jane Hubert.

Those present: Jane Hubert, Jean Ambrose, Roger Linton, Sam Snow, Ernie Martin, Sarah Perkins, Jim Lothridge and Jeanne Lothridge.

The Select Board received a letter from Bill Moulton with some suggestions for future use of the Town of Pittston's gravel pit property. The Select Board will review this letter and Jane Hubert will be in touch with Mr. Moulton.

Ernie Martin will be inspecting the road signs on Beech Hill Road and the Jewett Road for 911 issues.

A letter that will be sent to Ben Goodall, plowing contractor, was reviewed. The letter will include the words "requires adherence to the contract."

Sam Snow gave the Select Board a report of gradation from S.W. Cole for the winter sand. The standards for winter sand were met.

Blinn Hill Road Bridge is now open. Paperwork and invoices from S.W. Cole, Warren Construction and Coffin Engineering were reviewed. Sam Snow, Road Commissioner, has some questions. Jane Hubert will call Coffin Engineering to get clarification. Sam also wants to know who inspected the Blinn Hill project area, before the paving was done. Sam feels that the grade is not right, there is a dip in the road and the rain water does not flow correctly. Jane Hubert will speak to Coffin Engineering about this as well.

Sam Snow reported that the Nelson Road had been paved today.

There is a water drainage problem with a driveway on the Hunts Meadow Road that Sam Snow will attend to.

There will be a Mitigation Grant Application Workshop on Oct. 27, 2015 @ 9.00 a.m. Sarah Perkins, Sam Snow and Deb M will attend. Jane Hubert and Jean Ambrose may possibly attend.

A water runoff problem affecting a driveway on the Palmer Road has been fixed.

The signs for the school zone on Pittston School Street have been picked up.

A resident called the Town Office in regards to the status of the East Webb Road. Deb M. has been researching this and will call the resident to invite him to come to the next Select Board meeting.

The situation with D & M Auto sales will be reviewed at a Planning Board meeting on Oct. 22, 2015.

The ambulance contract with Gardiner was signed. Pittston will not be charged for uncollectibles unless they break the contract.

The Riverside recycling report was reviewed. A copy will be sent to Ann Pistell, Chair of the Recycling Committee. Jane Hubert will ask Ann where Riverside takes the recycled material that is picked up in Pittston.

A question was asked if Pittston will be continuing with the Richmond Transfer Station after Oct. 31, 2015. Jane Hubert will call Richmond.

A letter announcing a transfer station operators training program was reviewed. There was no interest in attending.

A letter of transmittal regarding Pittston's Health Officer was reviewed. Deb M. will make sure that this department has updated information.

It was reported that Deb Sullivan, Animal Control Officer, will be able to attend the October ACO training class.

Jane Hubert made a motion to approve the Select Board meeting minutes for September 30, 2015. Roger Linton 2<sup>nd</sup>. It was a 3-0 vote.

Warrant #40 was signed.

Jean Ambrose made a motion to approve preview warrant #41 in the amount of \$68,301.06. Jane Hubert 2<sup>nd</sup>, it was a 3-0 vote.

Jane Hubert made a motion to approve payroll warrant #4115 in the amount of \$2,252.43. Roger Linton 2<sup>nd</sup>. It was a 3-0 vote.

Jane Hubert made a motion to adjourn at 7:15 p.m. Jean Ambrose 2<sup>nd</sup>. It was a 3-0 vote.
