- a. **Old Cedar Grove Road – Washout Repair** has been completed
- b. **Hunts Meadow Road – Pothole** Jane Hubert called Whitefield to verify the pothole is in Pittston. Sam Snow (Road Commissioner) stated that he charges “state wages” and is not on the list to repair and is not interested in completing the repair. Jane Hubert will address the issue and arrange the repair.
- c. **Riverwalk Sign & Passage** It is easy for people to drive around the gate and it needs to be blocked. Joe Caputo had previously suggested moving boulders to block people from going around the barrier.
- d. **Jewett Road – Potholes** Pine Tree is evaluating the road.
- e. **Nash Road** Sam Snow (Road Commissioner) did not replace the missing “curve ahead” sign, but will.
