

Pittston Select Board Meeting Minutes

April 18, 2018

Those present: Roger Linton, Greg Lumbert, Sam Snow, Jaimy Snow, Jim Lothridge, Jeannie Lothridge, Sarah Perkins and Albert Lilly.

The meeting was called to order by Chair, Roger Linton, at 6:00 p.m.

Sam Snow, Road Commissioner, said that we just need 1 recorder for the traffic counter and he could pick it up 4/20/18 at 11:00 or later.

Greg Lumbert made a motion to approve the Paving RFP as corrected. Roger Linton 2nd. It was a 2-0 vote.

The new proposal for roadside mowing was tabled until Sam Snow can speak with Rick Drew.

An update on moving the CMP poles on the Beech Hill Road was given by Greg Lumbert. He will call CMP again next week.

Deb M will look at the Town pit for small flat rocks for a landscaping project for the Town Office.

Sam Snow reported that all the intersections in Town have been swept and that Spicer Tree has almost finished with the tree trimming. Street signs have been fixed.

Greg Lumbert made a motion to approve the Select Board minutes of April 11, 2018. Roger Linton 2nd. It was a 2-0 vote.

Sarah Perkins, Tax Collector/Treasurer, spoke with the Select Board about the Riverside Disposal bill for recycling. Riverside is now charging the Town an additional fee of \$51.00 per ton, because there is no money in recycling. The bill was for 1 month and the additional cost was \$412.59. This extra money has not been budgeted for. Sarah explained some options. The Recycling Committee will be asked to come to the SB meeting on April 25th at 6:30 to discuss this matter. Greg Lumbert does not want to pay this additional fee because residents can go to Hatch Hill for the price of their sticker, \$15.00.

Where to take money to pay for Attorney fees was discussed. Sarah Perkins said that it should come out of contingency. Sarah needs to leave between \$3,000 and \$4,000 in that account to cover abatements.

Warrant #15 was signed.

Greg Lumbert made a motion to approve preview warrant #16 in the amount of \$17,711.61. Roger Linton 2nd. It was a 2-0 vote.

Greg Lumbert made a motion to approve payroll warrant #1618 in the amount of \$2,408.26. Roger Linton 2nd. It was a 2-0 vote.

Update on Laurie Adams/Ballard provided by Ernie Martin, CEO. Ms. Adams called Ernie and the dangerous trailer on her property will be removed by Riverside Disposal in the next few weeks. Ms. Ballard also inquired how much money she still owes the Town of Pittston from years ago when she got her septic system. Ernie will get back to her when he finds out that information.

Nat Hahn, Recycling Attendant, came to the Select Board to discuss a few items. Greg Lumbert made a motion to approve Nate to have April 28th off. He will still open and close the recycling area, he will not stay for the day. Roger Linton 2nd. It was a 2-0 vote. Nate reported the fence is broken from plowing. Sam Snow will look at it. The dirt is uneven between the bins and where he parks his car. Sam will look at it. The Select Board mentioned that there is some trash at the recycling area that will need to be picked up. Nate reported that things are going well. He helps those residents that want help.

Greg Lumbert made a motion to adjourn at 6:52 p.m. Roger Linton 2nd. It was a 2-0 vote.
