

Pittston Select Board Meeting Minutes

January 12, 2022

Those present: Jean Ambrose, Rodney Hembree, Kerri Farris (via zoom), Jane Hubert, Wellman Cromwell, Bruce Engert, Sam Snow and Deb MacInnes.

The meeting was called to order by Chair, Jean Ambrose, at 5:32 p.m.

Rodney Hembree made a motion to approve the Select Board meeting minutes of December 22, 2021, as written. Jean Ambrose 2nd. It was a 2-0-1 vote.

A warning letter was finalized for the offender that has been using the Palmer Road in an overweight truck.

Paperwork to use the Pittston Randolph Consolidated School for the Pittston annual Town Meeting, was signed.

Rodney Hembree made a motion to approve preview warrant #2 in the amount of \$22,032.44. Jean Ambrose 2nd. It was a 3-0 vote.

Rodney Hembree made a motion to approve payroll warrant 222 in the amount of \$3,377.27. Jean Ambrose 2nd. It was a 3-0 vote.

Bruce Engert, Code Enforcement Officer, gave an update on the property on the Jewett Road that was served with a violation. Bruce told the Select Board that this has been going on for years and it is time to involve the Town attorney. Kerri Farris made a motion to contact the Town attorney and share details of the notice of violation, to act properly, pursuit of enforcement and concerned about contamination. Jean Ambrose 2nd. It was a 3-0 vote.

The "Heavy Loads Limit" signs were discussed.

The sand for residents at the sand/salt shed was discussed. Sam Snow, Road Commissioner, reported that some people have been filling the back of their pick-up trucks. A notice will be made and posted.

The warrant articles for the Town Meeting were reviewed.

A Public Hearing for the new proposed updated Building Code Ordinance will be scheduled for February 16, 2022.

Jane Hubert, Chair of the Recycling Committee, reported that the new Recycling Attendant started and did a very good job under bad weather conditions.

Keys/locks for the Recycling Center were discussed.

The draft Marijuana Ordinance was discussed.
