



Pittston Select Board Meeting Minutes

March 16, 2022

Those present: Jean Ambrose, Rodney Hembree, Kerri Farris, Jane Hubert, Wellman Cromwell, Sam Snow and Deb MacInnes.

The meeting was called to order by Chair, Jean Ambrose at 5:30 p.m.

Rodney Hembree made a motion to approve the Select Board meeting minutes of March 9, 2022, as written. Jean Ambrose 2nd. It was a 2-0-1 vote.

Kerri Farris made a motion to approve preview warrant #11 in the amount of \$10,411.24. Rodney Hembree 2nd. It was a 3-0 vote.

Kerri Farris made a motion to approve payroll warrant #1122 in the amount of \$3,372.38. Rodney Hembree 2nd. It was a 3-0 vote.

The checkbook balance is \$1,429,069.78.

The Office received one quote to fix the front office floor. The quote included replacing the entire floor, pulling up the carpet and other things. The quote was for \$5,000 which included materials. More quotes will be sought after.

Cyber security paperwork was reviewed. More work will be done on this.

Email accounts were discussed. Sheldon Arford, Pittston's IT person, has suggested going to GoDaddy. Kerri Farris was hoping for more written comparisons between GoDaddy and Gov Office other than just the cost. Sheldon discussed this with the Select Board on March 11, 2022. Kerri Farris stated that she thinks it is reasonable for each Select Board member to have their own email address. Kerri Farris made a motion to have 3 Select Board emails. There was no 2nd. Kerri Farris noted that the resistance to 3 emails is uncomfortable, she believes this is a better way to be transparent. Jean Ambrose stated that she was uncomfortable also and feels that 3 separate emails is less transparent. This topic was tabled until the next Select Board meeting.

A discussion was held in regards to setting up the Zoom account to Zoom all the Select Board meetings.

An Entrance permit was signed. There was a meeting with the resident, DOT, Rodney Hembree and Road Commissioner, Sam Snow. DOT approved the location.
