



Pittston Select Board Meeting Minutes

March 9, 2022

Those present: Jean Ambrose, Rodney Hembree, Jane Hubert, Wellman Cromwell, Pete Kelley, Sam Snow and Deb MacInnes.

A “No action” letter for Pete Kelley was signed.

Rodney Hembree made a motion to approve the Select Board meeting minutes of March 2, 2022, as written. Jean Ambrose 2nd. It was a 2-0 vote.

Rodney Hembree made a motion to approve preview warrant #10 in the amount of \$16,151.81, as written. Jean Ambrose 2nd. It was a 2-0 vote.

Rodney Hembree made a motion to approve payroll warrant #1022 in the amount of \$3,685.15, as written. Jean Ambrose 2nd. It was a 2-0 vote.

A Beano letter for the Pittston Firefighter’s Association was signed.

Sam Snow, Road Commissioner, reported that there are more “mud runs” with the frost coming out.

Sam Snow checked three different places to find roadside mowing equipment for rent. Rental cost is \$2,500 and another \$2,000 for gas and labor.

Sam Snow will reach out to a couple of tree cutting services to get some trees cut on the Kelley Road and on the Warren Road. He will choose the cheapest company.

A culvert on the Warren Road will need to be replaced.

The Town of Pittston has received two Stream Crossing Grants from DEP. Each grant is for \$125,000. One is for the Blodgett Road and the other is for the Pinkham Road. St. Germain Engineering will be notified to move forward with the Blodgett Road proposal. There will need to be a meeting with St. Germain in regards to the Pinkham Road. Sam Snow will contact St. Germain.

An invoice from CSI was discussed.

Some issues on the Jewett Road will be fixed at a later date.
