

PITTSTON SELECT BOARD MEETING

December 16, 2015

Those present: Jane Hubert, Jean Ambrose, Roger Linton, Sam Snow, Sarah Perkins, and Bruce Engert.

The meeting was called to order by Chair, Jane Hubert at 6:00p.m.

Sam Snow, Road Commissioner, reported the following:

- Jim Coffin, Coffin Engineering, called him to say that he was going to look at the Blodgett Road on 12/17/15 in regards to the culvert grant. Mr. Coffin will have grant information ready soon.
- Brush cutting has been done on the Nash Road, Blinn Hill Road, Old Cedar Grove Road, Warren Road, Stage Road, and the Blodgett Road.
- Spicer tree service is going to cut some high limbs on the Kelley Road and the Nash Road. They will cut a tree on the Jewett Road.
- A 35 mile an hour speed limit sign needs to be ordered for the Old Cedar Grove Road. Deb M. will do this.
- The fence at the recycling area may be installed next week and also the pot holes filled in.
- Shoulder work will be done on the Pinkham Road and the Kelley Road next week.

The Select Board had a discussion with Bruce Engert, Code Enforcement Officer, about the East Webb Road. The Select Board decided to send Steve McGee another certified letter. A copy of the general notes on the subdivision plans will be included with the letter. Mr. McGee will have until Dec. 31, 2015 to respond. Jane Hubert made a motion to send certified mail, the aforementioned letter to Steve McGee. Jean Ambrose 2nd. It was a 3-0 vote.

The election counting machine contract extension was signed.

The Richmond Transfer Station contract was signed by Richmond and returned. It will be filed.

An email was reviewed from Bruce Flaherty, Spirit of America. February 28, 2016 is the deadline for Pittston's 2016 Spirit of America recipient.

An update was given on the Home Fire Preparedness Campaign. 48 residents have signed up so far.

Jane Hubert made a motion to approve the Select Board minutes of December 9, 2015. Roger Linton 2nd. It was a 3-0 vote.

Warrant #49 was signed.

Jean Ambrose made a motion to approve preview warrant #50 in the amount of \$7,799.96. Roger Linton 2nd. It was a 3-0 vote.

Roger Linton made a motion to approve payroll warrant #5015 in the amount of \$13,129.51. Jean Ambrose 2nd. It was a 3-0 vote.

Sarah Perkins, tax Collector/Treasurer, had a discussion with the Select Board in regards to tax payments being received. Sarah also reported that she will be attending a Trio workshop in Bangor on 12/17/15.

Deb M. will contact Jim Lothridge, Chair of the Personnel Committee, to see when the Personnel Committee Meeting will be held.
